- I. SUPERVISOR GARRICK CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER AT 6:30 PM.
- II. SUPERVISOR GARRICK, COUNCILMAN REILLY, COUNCILMAN GALM AND COUNCILMAN COONS WERE ALL PRESENT.

RE ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING

- ON A MOTION BY COUNCILMAN GALM SECONDED COUNCILMAN REILLY AND CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY JOHN (FRASER) PATERSON WAS APPOINTED TO THE EMPTY TOWN BOARD SEAT FOR ONE YEAR.
- SUPERVISOR GARRICK ANNOUNCED THE APPOINTMENTS FOR 2012, ATTACHED.
- SUPERVISOR GARRICK RESIGNED FROM HIS SEAT ON THE PLANNING BOARD.
- ON A MOTION BY COUNCILMAN REILLY SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN GALM THE 2012 APPOINTMENTS WERE ACCEPTED.
- SUPERVISOR GARRICK, COUNCILMAN REILLY, COUNCILMAN GALM, COUNCILMAN PATERSON ALL VOTED YES, COUNCILMAN COON ABSTAINED SINCE HWY SUPERINTENDANT EARL COONS AND ROBERT COONS, HIS BROTHERS, WERE REAPPOINTED.
- ON A MOTION BY COUNCILMAN REILLY SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN COONS AND CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY THE TOWN OF GALLATIN EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS PLAN COMMITTEE WAS FORMED. SUPERVISOR GARRICK NAMED MRS. ELAINE LEVY TO CHAIR THE COMMITTEE. MRS. LEVY WILL ASK OTHER TOWN RESIDENTS TO JOIN HER ON THE COMMITTEE.

- THERE WAS A LENGTHY DISCUSSION OF THE SEATING ARRANGEMENT FOR THE BOARD, VARIOUS CONFIGURATIONS WILL BE LOOKED AT.
- ON A MOTION BY COUNCILMAN REILLY SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN GALM AND CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY SUPERVISOR GARRICK, COUNCILMAN PATERSON AND COUNCILMAN COONS WERE GIVEN PERMISSION TO ATTEND THE ASSOCIATION OF TOWNS NEWLY ELECTED OFFICERS TRAINING JAN 11-13 IN ALBANY AT A COST OF \$450 TOTAL.
