- IV. ON A MOTION BY COUNCILMAN SORMAN SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN TOIGO AND CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY THE MINUTES OF THE MAY 12, 2011 TOWN BOARD MEETING WERE ACCEPTED AS PRESENTED.
