February/March

The Highway Department continues to cut dead trees and brush along our town roads and by the courthouse. Because of the ground not being frozen for our biggest snow storms this year, we are looking at a large amount of clean-up when spring arrives and stays.

The new 2017 John Deere backhoe arrived on February 22.

63 days after it was ordered. After a lot of consideration I am recommending the sale of our 96 Case backhoe thru Auctions International. I do not believe repairing the trans and mounting a hammer is a good investment for the town.

Two roads, West Pond Lily and Koslowski, did not fare well with the temperature swings this winter. Both roads are beyond a oil & stone repair. I am waiting for bids on Motopave or Blacktop.

Oil & stone Bids are coming in for:

Taghkanic road (CR 8 to Green Acres)

Green Acres (CR 8 to New Motopave)

North Gold Road, Skiba Road, Siglar Road.

April 2017

The annual Rabies Clinic will be at the Highway Garage on May 6th from 10:00am to 12:00pm. I was at a meeting on Thursday afternoon with FEMA representatives to present information on the cost of the March 15th snow storm. Funding may be available due to a state of emergence declared on that day. The wet weather over the past couple of weeks has put our spring road sweeping ahead of schedule and we continue to do shoulder and ditch work thru out town.

The major road work I would suggest this year is:

West Pond Lily Road, Moto Pave and Chip sealing.

Kozlowski Road, Moto Pave and Chip sealing.

Taghkanic Road, CR8 to Marty Road, Chip sealing.

North Gold Road, Chip Sealing.

Green Acres Road, CR8 to North Gold, Chip sealing.

Wilmer Hill, Chip sealing.

I provided a more detailed account of cost via e-mail the 13th.

The Case Backhoe will be on Auctions International with the bids ending the day before the May meeting. The Board can accept or reject an offer at that meeting.

l am recommending the purchase of a 2017 GMC 3500 4x4 with back rack , amber leds, road temperature sensor, remote led spot light, 9ft municipal plow. This would be purchase under the OSG Municipal Pricing Plan for \$42,852.00 . The 2010 pickup could be sold thru Auction Internatioal.

May 2017

The Highway Department has finished its annual spring sweeping and continues cleaning the shoulders up from our plowing this winter. The Rabies clinic was held at the town garage on May $6^{\rm th}$ with 70 animals attending.

I meet with FEMA representatives on April 26th to provide additional information for the March 14th snow storm. It was explained to the towns that the state was short of the necessary threshold for reimbursement and that was the reason for gathering more information.

On May 4^{th} I attended a Cornell Roads seminar titled "Local Roads done Right ". It focused on Drainage, Base ,Wear Corse and Traffic Sighs.

The 96 Case Backhoe received a high bid of \$11.300 on the Auctions International's Webb site. I recommended accepting the bid.

Highway Report June 2017

The Highway Department has completed its first round of roadside mowing and continues with culvert replacement and ditch work. We have hauled in stone, on our many rainy days, for our upcoming projects. On June 7th the Department attended our annual OSHA training at the Chatam Fair Grounds. I have requested that AED certification be part of next training.

Clean Up Day will be held on October 28th this year at the Highway Garage.

July 2017

The Highway Department has completed the second round of road side mowing and has cleaned up after numerus strong thunder storms. Stone has been hauled in for our road projects and improvements to the base of these roads continues.

Under the Shared Services program we received help from Taghkanic with 3 trucks and a roller. We helped Ancram with 2 trucks on 6/8 and 3 trucks on6/9. We also helped Red Hook with 2 trucks.

August 2017

On August 3rd Lisa Deleeuw and I meet with the representatives from FEMA at the Ichabod Crane Middle School.It was called a "Kick Off Meeting". At this meeting they explain what documentation is necessary to file a claim on the March 14th and 15th snow storm. The new pick up was delivered on July 19th.

With the help of T/O Red Hook's Paver and T/O Taghkanic's Drag Box the roads that will be Oil & Stone are now ready for that work to be done in mid September.

Shared Services this month was T/O Red Hook's Paver, Roller and Truck for 3 days. T/O Taghkanic's Truck for 3 days. T/O Taghkanic's Drag Box and Roller for 5 days. We sent a truck to Ancram for 1 day and a truck to Taghkanic for 1 days.

Highway Report September 2017

On 9/8 and 9/11 we double chip sealed Marty road,
North Gold road, 1250ft of Kozlowski road, 2950ft of Green Acres road
and Taghkanic road from the county bridge to the Green Acres
intersection. We single chip sealed Wilmer Hill road and the portion of
Green Acre road. The single chip sealing was on the Moto Pave projects
from 2016. Work continued on Kozlowski road to prepare it and
West Pond Lily for Moto Paving later this month.

Under Shared Services we were in Red Hook with 2 trucks for 2 days. We received help for 2 days with 2 trucks from Ancram,1 truck for 2 days from Pine Plains and from Red Hook, Paver and roller for 1 day and 2 trucks for 3 days.

Highway Report October 2017

On the 27th and 28th of September we Motopaved West Pond Lily road and Kozlowski road. We did this with help from Pine Plains with 1 truck, Ancram with 2 trucks and Red Hook with 1 truck. All 3 towns helped us on both days.

The cemetery had its annual mowing and we have begun the final road side mowing of the year. Clean up day is on September 28th. The 2010 pickup has a high bid of \$12,600 thru Auctions International. I am recommending to the board to accept that bid.

Highway Report November 2017

The Town had its clean up day on October 28th. I would like to thank Rene Deleeuw and Heather Parson for once again helping us out. We are completing the road side mowing and removing leaves from poor drainage areas. We have started removing the many dead tress along our roads. On October 18th and 19th we paved Green Acres road with the help of the town of Red Hook and their paver. We also used the town of Taghkanic's drag box and roller for repairs along Skiba road.

December 2017

The Highway Department has been able to continued ditch work on our roads, thanks to the mild start to this winter. We are removing dead trees along our roads as weather allows.

This year we have installed 2000ft of road fabric on Karwacki and West Pond Lily roads. We have double chipped sealed 2.25 miles, Motopaved 1.5 mile and blacktopped .40 miles. We also single chipped sealed the Motopaved projects from last year. (about 1 mile)

In 2017 the Town purchased a new John Deere Backhoe and a new GMC pick up with plow. They replaced a 96 Case Backhoe and a 2010 Chevy pick up. Both of the replaced pieces of equipment were sold thru Auctions International.
