NEW BUSINESS SECTION 2018

1. Update on Bridge NY Culvert Grant program- Grant for the Camp Road culvert deck replacement will be submitted by April 13.
2. Review of emergency procedures- Town Hall- warming station -fuel-community center.
3. Broadband Update - Phase 3 funding Gallatin- All of Gallatin is covered by Broadband Funding. A draft lease will be drawn up for review concerning the lease of land by G-Tel at the highway garage for an electronics hut in exchange for high speed broadband at the Town Buildings.
4. Hoefer Road update by resident representative. Ben Maron of Hoefer Rd (a private road) came in front of the board again. He spoke of the conditions of the road during the winter. After a lengthy discussion Mr. Maron was told the procedure for the Town to

consider taking ownership of the road was spelled out to him previously. Mr. Maron should present a petition to the Town from the residents of Hoefer Rd. The road will need to become a separate parcel and a road district would have to be established.

5. Zoning review update: Discussion on what the life of a FCID should be. Discussion on updating the Comprehensive Plan. Any changes to the Comprehensive plan, must be reflected in a zoning update.
