**NEW BUSINESS SECTION 2018**

1. Official Town Map- procedure/road issues/private forests/unclaimed parcel issues. A copy of a 1958 Town Map was supplied by Columbia County Engineering Dept. This map will be updated to show current conditions, private and Town maintained roads.  
A map to show private forest land will be added to the collection of new Town Maps. Request will go to Columbia County Real Property to research and assign map numbers on unknown owner parcels.
2. Town Clerk to report on recyclables fee collection  
The permit stickers for County recycling will be available at the Town Hall, \$35 for Senior Citizen County Residents, \$50 for County Residents and \$100 for Non-County residents. The town receives \$5 for each permit sold.
3. Camp Road Bridge between Beaver Rd and Jackson Corners Rd will be posted with a weight reduction within the next 2 years.
