**ADOPTION OF THE TOWN OF GALLATIN LOCAL CLIMATE CHANGE ADAPTATION AND RESILIENCE PLAN**

At a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Gallatin, Columbia County, New York, duly held on the 17<sup>TH</sup> day of June, 2025, at the Town Hall, 667 Route 7 Gallatin, New York, the following Resolution was proposed and seconded:

**WHEREAS**, Gallatin pledged to take part in the NYS DEC Climate Smart Communities Certification Program that includes the preparation of a Vulnerability Assessment and Climate Adaptation Plan; and
