Ancram Camp/Pool

Camp is free for Ancram kids, and costs \$75 per week for non-Ancram kids. But for non-Ancram Kids, but we offer "scholarships" to attend Camp based on need. This year, in cooperation with Ancramdale Neighbors Helping Neighbors and the Regional Food Bank of Northeastern NY, all campers and swimmers will be offered free nutritional bag lunches including milk, juice and fruit every day of camp, through the USDA Food for Kids Summer program.

The pool is managed Head Lifeguard Johanna Boice, employs 6 lifeguards, and costs \$30,000 to operate for the summer - \$15,000 for lifeguards, and \$15,000 for all other costs. The Camp is run by Camp Director Samantha Mason, employs five counselors and costs \$15,000 to run each summer. In addition to our \$45,000 in annual operating costs, we are investing \$25,000 this year to renovate the changing rooms and bathrooms at the pool, to resurface the deck area around the pool, and to replace the pool fence.
