PROJECT BACKGROUND

This locally administered Bridge NY transportation project was initiated by the Columbia County Department of Public Works to address the declining structural integrity of the County Route 7 Culvert over the Tributary to the Roeliff Jansen Kill.

Engineering consultant, Greenman-Pedersen, Inc. (GPI) was selected by the county to perform the required Engineering, Environmental studies, and Design tasks to meet the project objectives.

PROJECT OBJECTIVES

- Replacement of the structurally deficient culvert with a new structure that will provide a minimum service life of 75 years;
- Address localized drainage, erosion, and culvert scour issues;
- Provide a structure that blends with the character of the surrounding community.

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

Preliminary plans showing the proposed culvert replacement alternatives that are being considered will be provided at the meeting for public view.

These plans do not show all proposed improvements that may be required but are intended to assist in obtaining public input.

The following alternatives will be presented:

Alt 1 - No-Build (Null Option)

Alt 2 - Culvert Rehabilitation

Alt 3a - Culvert Replacement with a Three Sided Rigid Frame (Concrete) Bridge

Alt 3b - Culvert Replacement with Concrete
 Integral Abutments and Steel Girder
 Bridge

Once a preferred alternative is selected by the county and design approval is granted by NYSDOT, final design will commence.

TRAFFIC CONTROL DURING CONSTRUCTION

The bridge will need to be closed to all vehicular, pedestrian, and bicycle traffic during construction. County Route 11 and State Route 82 are proposed to be used as a detour.

PROJECT FUNDING

The total construction cost for this project is currently programmed at \$1,620,000.

This project is being jointly funded by the State of New York's Bridge NY program, and by participating funds from Columbia County.

ENVIRONMENTAL COMPLIANCE

Environmental review of this project is currently being conducted. This project is anticipated to be classified as a SEQR Type II in accordance with 6 NYCRR Section 617.5.


